Scabiosa columbaria 'Butterfly Blue'



Common Name:
Pincushion Flower

This plant produces a profusion of lavender-blue, pincushion-like flowers over a very long period beginning in late spring. They sit atop wiry stems which hover over the short mound of ferny basal foliage. They make excellent cut flowers and also attract butterflies.

Height: 12.0-18.0 Inches

Hardiness Zones: 3 - 9

Sunlight: Full Sun (> 6 hrs. Direct Sun)

Soil Quality: Average to Fertile

Bloom Time: Late Spring to Late Summer

Spread: 15.0 Inches

Flower Color: Blue shades, Foliage: Green shades

Water Requirements: Low to Average Water Needs

Chemistry: Neutral to Alkaline Soil (pH 7.0 or greater)
