

# Plant "Imagination"

## *Lilium martagon*



*Lilium martagon* (Martagon or Turk's cap lily) is a species of [lily](#).

It is native from eastern France east through northern Asia to Mongolia and Korea. It likes cold temperatures. Several subspecies have been named. Horticulturally it is considered a true species. It is stem-rooting, growing between 3 to 6 feet tall. The flower color is typically a pink-purple, with dark spots, but is quite variable, extending from near white to near black. The flowers are scented. Numerous flowers are borne on each plant, and up to 50 can be found on vigorous plants. The green stems can be flushed with purple or red and the leaves are elliptic to inverse [lanceolate](#), mostly in whorls, up to 16 cm long and often lightly hairy underneath.
